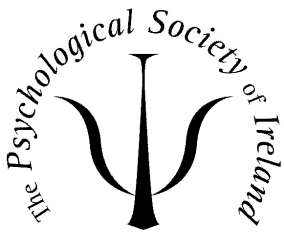

APPLICATION FOR STUDENT SUBSCRIBERSHIP: INFORMATION

Please read the information below before you complete the application form overleaf.

What is “Student Subscribership”?

Student Subscribership is a subscription to The Psychological Society of Ireland (PSI, the professional association of Psychologists in Ireland) which is available only to registered students on approved third-level Degree or Diploma courses in Psychology.

*Applicants are requested to note that acceptance of a candidate for Student Subscribership of The Psychological Society of Ireland **does not automatically confer eligibility for Graduate Membership of that Society.***

What are my entitlements as a Student Subscriber of PSI?

As a Student Subscriber, you will receive access electronically to a monthly bulletin (**The Irish Psychologist**), a quarterly scientific journal (**The Irish Journal of Psychology**) and regular details of Psychology news, lectures, meetings (e.g. The Annual Congress of Students of Psychology in Ireland) and social events. Reductions in fees to the PSI Annual Conference and other meetings are also available to Student Subscribers.

Am I eligible for Student Subscribership?

Student Subscribership is available only to people who are not eligible for Graduate Membership: You cannot be a Student Subscriber if you possess an honours degree or equivalent in Psychology from a recognised institution. If you are unsure of your eligibility, please provide full details of any qualifications in Psychology which you have already obtained.

Evidence that you are engaged in undergraduate study must be provided. (e.g. university stamp, photocopy of student card etc.)

How much does it cost?

The annual fee for Student Subscribership is **€25.00**. Your application will not be processed by PSI if this fee is not enclosed with the completed form overleaf. PSI's year ends at the end of December, so Student Subscribers may continue in that category until the end of the PSI year in which their studies in Psychology are completed.

How and where do I apply?

Completed application forms for Student Subscribership (which must be signed by two current PSI Graduate Members) should be sent, with the appropriate fee to:
